1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded.

- North Country Elementary provides after-school art academies, once a week, 1.75 hours each session. The following Academies are available to students: Film Making Academy, Drawing Academy, Art and Sculpting Academy, Music Academy, Theatre Academy. Instruction is provided by 4 certificated and 1 classified employee. All are paid on timecards.
- Spinelli Elementary provides art instruction 4 days per week under the direction of 1 certificated full time employee. TK-6 students rotate during the school day. Using different mediums, students create projects that relate to the Wonders themes in their ELA curriculum.
