REPORTS/PRESENTATIONS

1. Williams Uniform Complaint Quarterly Reporting - George Tigner, Chief Administrative Officer, reported that there were no complaints to report.

Education Technology K-12 Voucher Program - Craig Deason, Assistant Superintendent Operations & Facilities, noted that we applied for these vouchers. Global, AVCS and Oak Hill did not qualify for the money through the Free & Reduced Lunch Program. The money was initially set aside for the computer match program. He noted that the vouchers can be redeemed up until September of 2012.

Trustee Anderson asked if we could pass the money on to the sites. Mr. Deason noted that we do need to stick to our Tech Plan. It could be used for technical support or to purchase more computers. He feels that the best idea is to set it aside for a computer emergency (crash).

Trustee Wilson asked if we would get the money back right away. Mr. Deason said that it is a long process and would not happen right away.

- 3. California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act Craig Deason, Assistant Superintendent Operations & Facilities, shared information on how this would provide a bidding process that would save the District time and money on contracted maintenance projects and small construction projects. Mr. Deason added that he would like to bring two resolutions to the next Board meeting to be approved. Trustee Wilson asked if there is a minimum requirement for bidders. Mr. Deason noted that we don't have a problem with getting several bids right now. Mark Rosson, from CPM, reported that 3-5 bidders would be adequate. Trustee Anderson asked how these groups of bidders are started. Mark Rosson noted that there are notices that go out to the contractors annually, but anyone can be added at any time.
- 4. 09-10 TRANs Update Jeanne Bess, Director of Fiscal Services, shared with the Board the information that she received this afternoon: they intend to sell the notes next Tuesday, and it will then close on 4-27-10. It will be a cost of issuance of \$2.8 million will be between \$15,000-17,000. The interest rate would be between .75% 1%. Piper Jaffray is looking at timing the repayment of the TRAN with the payment from the State. She noted that as of today, we are \$1.1 million in the hole. It is being covered by other funds currently in the account.
