STUDENT BOARD REPRESENTATIVE REPORTS

1. Center High School - Millennium Chaovong was not available to report.
2. McClellan High School - Tristan Wallenmeyer
 - There is a leadership class offered; the goal of the class will be to provide opportunities for students to interact with each other on campus in non-academic ways and to increase the sense of family.
 - Santa will be visiting McClellan on Friday, delivering holiday cheer to all of the students.
 - Mrs. Baioni's Art class has created artwork to be displayed on each of the classroom doors to help spread cheer.
 - The MHS Title I Intervention program has been successful this year. The after school tutoring and help sessions have helped boost students' understanding and grades in English, Math, Social Studies, and Science. It will continue throughout the year.
 - McClellan is working to improve student attendance, recognizing and rewarding students who have no tardies and no absences each week. This program is new, but students are responding positively.
 - The flag football team won their tournament on October 13th; four teams competed at Mahany field in Roseville. McClellan won all 4 games.
 - The volleyball team competed today in a tournament at Chana High School. After several tough games, McClellan emerged as the champions of the league in volleyball.
 - Thanked all students, staff and district personnel who have donated to the food drive. All donations are being used to stock McClellan's Food Pantry.
 - The Antelope Lion's Club donated 2 Thanksgiving dinners, and current and former staff donated 13 more. They were able to provide 15 McClellan families with a Thanksgiving meal.
 - Additionally, they were able to give 7 McClellan students each a \$100 WalMart gift card thanks to Antelope Lion's Club and from contributions from McClellan staff and friends.
 - Ron Baioni has gathered up several government surplus computers for the staff and students. Mr. Collins' class received 8 computers, Mr. Hagman's students received 4 computers, and Mr. Ridge's students have 14 more class computers, all from state and federal surplus. Additionally, teachers, office staff, and our preschool have received larger monitors and printers. They are all benefitting from Mr. Baioni's surplus efforts.

E. APPROVED - First Interim Report for Fiscal Year 2016/17

Lisa Coronado thanked her office staff for helping her. She also thanked Jeanne Bess for coming in during Thanksgiving Break to answer questions and help her. Looking over her report, she discussed the amount lowered because of ADA being down and the increase in some grant money. She also noted that the FCMAT calculator will not be updated until the January 17th budget release. At that time she will be able to do a more accurate projection. In expenditures, there was a large amount of carryover from the previous year so the district is able to finally address the needs. Expenditures are up because they are planning on using the one time money for purchasing buses, freezers, forklift, curriculum, etc. CUTA has requested a wish list from its membership; CSEA will be doing that as well. Salaries and benefits are staying flat. Cash flow is staying solid. We are able to meet our financial needs this year, and the next 2 years out, so we are asking for a positive certification.

Trustee Kelley noted that our reserve was suppose to be \$1.3 million, but glad to see that we were able to reserve \$6.1 million. She asked what the "contributions" were; it was noted that contributions are monies that we earmark for instruction materials, technology, special education, and other things like that. Trustee Wilson asked if the amounts were contiguous (from page to page); it was noted that they are not. Mr. Loehr noted that Marie Huggins has informed him that she had received \$90,000 in Developer Fees linked to the new homes being built.

This memorandum of understanding (MOU) confirms and clarifies the parties' mutual understanding and agreement regarding the temporary payment of 2017 health and welfare benefits premium increases:

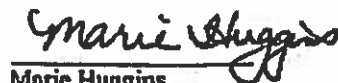
1. Classified employees will have deducted from their December 30, 2016 paycheck, the full amount of their monthly increase to 2017 health and welfare benefit premiums.
2. Beginning with the January 31, 2017 paycheck, the District will pay in advance of a settlement, the full amount of any increase to health and welfare benefit premiums for classified employees. This arrangement will remain in effect until a settlement is reached between the District and CSEA #610 regarding health and welfare benefits for 2017 and wages for the school year 2016-17, but no longer than June 30, 2017.
3. After settlement is reached between the District and CSEA #610 regarding health and welfare benefits for 2017 and wages for the school year 2016-17, each classified employee shall reimburse to the District the amount of potential overpayment of health and welfare benefit premiums that was paid by the District under this agreement. Such reimbursement shall be deducted from any retroactive pay, if any, that the classified employee may receive as a result of the settlement.
4. In the event that retroactive pay is not part of the settlement, or if the retroactive pay is insufficient to cover the increased premiums already paid by the District, the classified employee shall reimburse to the District the overpayment. This will be accomplished by payroll deductions spread evenly over a four (4) month period immediately following the settlement being reached.

Wilson C. Riles Middle School is a 7th-8th grade middle school that has been open for ten years and is located in Roseville, California. The city of Roseville is in a rapidly growing area of the western portion of Placer County. Riles currently serves approximately 670 students. Our students come from various cultural heritages and backgrounds.

Based on Riles' mission statement and on the belief that all children can learn, the staff ensures that every student at Riles Middle School will engage in an academic course consistent with the California Standards focusing on high expectations for student performance in a supportive environment. Wilson C. Riles has a Gifted and Talented (GATE) Academy, Honors courses, Integrated One Math course and AVID elective classes. Through these programs, students receive differentiated instruction, support, and enrichment. Students receive academic intervention and enrichment through our "Husky Help" after school tutoring by teachers, as well as our Math Support classes.

Riles Middle School students are treated with dignity while being held to the highest behavioral standards. Rules and expectations are clearly communicated and are based on individual respect and safety considerations. Our School-Wide Positive Behavior Intervention and Support Plan (SWPBIS) was adopted during the 2009-2010 school year and is followed by students and staff members.

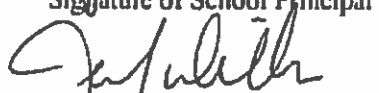
