

Plan 2 Hybrid Overview Link




Elementary In-Person

On-Campus 5 Days a Week

- Students attend class on campus Monday through Friday.
- All students, TK-6, will be placed in a morning or afternoon group. Students will attend school during their scheduled group time. All efforts will be made to assign family members to the same group.
- Each group will attend 2.5 hours per school day with a primary focus on English Language Arts and math.
- Facilities will be disinfected between morning and afternoon sessions.
- Students will complete independent work outside of the class day.

Independent Work

Kindergarten	30 minutes
1st-3rd grade	80 minutes
4th-6th grade	90 minutes



Elementary Distance Learning


Distance Learning 5 Days a Week

Families can opt-out of the on-campus model and continue in a distance learning format. This option may require being assigned a new teacher.

- Students attend class online Monday through Friday.
- 60 minutes of online office hours with teachers and other staff per day provide 1:1 and/or small group assistance
- At least 30 minutes intervention time (RTI, rotation, Tier II) in small group or individual sessions in addition to the whole class live session and office hours, as needed, to support academic progress.
- Offline independent student work which will be assigned by the teacher according to grade level:

Independent Work in Addition to Online Instruction

Kindergarten	120 minutes
1st-3rd grade	170 minutes
4th-6th grade	180 minutes



Middle School In-Person

On-Campus 5 Days a Week

Distance Learning 5 Days a Week

- Students attend class on campus Monday through Friday.
- Students will be split into morning and afternoon groups and will attend school during their assigned time.
- Morning and afternoon sessions will be approximately three hours in length each school day.
- Students attend three classes per day on an A/B day <u>schedule</u>.
- One hour of independent work will also be completed daily.
- Facilities will be disinfected between morning and afternoon sessions.

Families can opt-out of the on-campus model and continue in a distance learning format. This option may require being assigned a new teacher(s).

- Students attend class online Monday through Friday.
- Students are expected to participate in the live online and independent work for a total of 240 minutes.

Center High School

- Center High School will continue the A/B schedule.
- Students will be assigned to one of two tracks - Blue or Gold.
- On a rotating schedule, one group will attend class in-person on campus while the other group participates in class online from home. This allows for students to be on campus for a minimum of two days per week following a 2-week rotation schedule.

CHS Rotation

Week 1 & Week 2

Blue is in-person on campus for A Days and online for B Days.

Gold is in-person on campus for B Days and online for A Days

Week 3 & Week 4

Blue switches to in-person on campus classes on B Days and at-home online classes on A Day.

Gold switches to in-person on campus classes on B Days and at-home online classes on A Day.

*At the completion of week 4 students switch back to the week 1 & week 2 schedule


Full-Time Distance Learning




Wilson C. Riles Family Survey Results


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
Center High Family Survey Results



Guiding Considerations

Sacramento County has been cleared to return to in-person instruction with specific guidelines by Sacramento County Public Health and CA Department of Public Health

Elementary schools' first trimester ends November 6, 2020

Secondary semester ends December 18, 2020

Provide families with at least two weeks or more notification prior to the return date

Sufficient Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and sanitation inventory at each school site available

Nutrition and Transportation services are prepared to serve our students with only a few minor adjustments needed

Still in progress

- The hiring of four additional health techs to have one at each site
- The hiring of replacement teachers for those who state they won't return to in-person
- Finalizing all family results from the survey
- Adjusting classes/schedules based on the survey results
- Finalizing MOU with CUTA

Potential Return Dates

November 9, 2020 = 12 distance learning school days remaining (October 22 - Nov 6, 2020), 24 in-person school days to winter break (November 9 - December 18, 2020).

November 30, 2020 = 21 distance learning school days remaining (October 22 - November 20, 2020; no school for Thanksgiving week November 23 - 27), 15 in-person school days to Winter Break (November 30 - December 18, 2020).

<u>January 5, 2021</u> = 36 distance learning school days remaining to Winter Break (October 22 - December 18, 2020)
