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**SUBJECT: Transition to Plan 2 Hybrid Model**

The Board is being asked to consider the proposed return to in-person reopening calendar for our school as present as back-up to this item.

The approval of these dates would allow us to transition to our in-person Plan 2 Hybrid model (which is a modified daily schedule) as outlined in our CJUSD Playbook. Any student not wishing to return to this in-person instructional model may remain in a 100% distance learning model for the remainder of the school year. Families wishing to adjust their previous selection regarding in-person or distance learning may contact their school office and make that adjustment. Additionally, if a family would like to confirm their previous selection they may contact their student's school office. (Please note that a family may adjust their selection at a later date, even after the transition to Plan 2 Hybrid has occurred.)
