Updates

1) Last night, the CJUSD Board of Trustees discussed the current COVID-19 status in Sacramento County and Placer County. Both counties continue to remain in the Purple Tier status and are under a stay-at-home order, and as a result, our schools are currently not able to return for in-person learning. Therefore, our district will remain in a distance learning model and not reopen for in-person instruction on January 5th. The Board will continue to meet and review the COVID-19 data to make a future determination as to when we may safely return to some form of in-person instruction (Plan 2).

Additionally, the Board determined that our TK - 6 student schedules will remain the same when we return from break in January. Our elementary schools will not be adjusting their daily schedules until we can enter our Plan 2 (hybrid) model.

We continue to appreciate your support and understanding as we work to keep our district community safe and healthy.
