#### **TYPICAL DUTIES:**

- 1. Work at all school sites:
- 2. Serve as the lead in professional growth activities in elementary and secondary schools in English, mathematics, and proven instructional best practices;
- 3. Keep teachers informed about professional growth activities outside and inside the district:
- 4. Focus on classes and teachers of classes whose students are at risk of not passing the California High School Exit Exam, or who are below standard in math and English;
- 5. Conduct demonstration lessons;
- 6. Coordinate professional development activities while utilizing local resources;
- 7. Provide motivation and support for all staff members;
- 8. Conduct focused observations and provide specific feedback to teachers;
- 9. Assist classroom teachers in planning appropriate instruction;
- 10. Provide formal and informal staff development related to both research and practice for classroom teachers and administrators.
