JOB TITLE: Groundskeeper

DESCRIPTION OF BASIC RESPONSIBILITIES

To perform general and varied gardening work including unskilled and semi-skilled grounds maintenance and repair work.

SUPERVISOR: Director of Maintenance/Operations/Transportation

TYPICAL DUTIES:

- 1. Plants, cultivates, prunes, and waters trees, hedges, shrubs, and flowers to maintain attractiveness and health.
- 2. Prepares and treats soil for planting and weed control.
- 3. Maintains lawns and turf re-seeding, edging, and weeding as necessary.
- 4. Rakes leaves and hoes weeds.
- 5. Mixes and applies insecticides, fungicides and herbicides, sets bait and traps to maintain assigned areas free from pest and plant diseases.
- 6. Checks safety hazards in planted and playground areas of each District facility.
- 7. Installs, repairs, maintains and adjusts sprinklers and sprinkler systems.
- 8. Cleans and maintains drains and flow lines free from debris.
- 9. Assists in laying out and marking athletic and recreation fields.
- 10. Prepares grounds, ball fields, courtyards, flower beds to provide adequate, attractive and safe areas for assemblies and/or recreational activity.
- 11. Transports a variety of equipment to provide materials and supplies at job site as required to complete tasks.
- 12. Mows lawn areas with power mower and edges around walks and shrub areas.
- 13. Weeds and cleans around shrub areas and trees.
- 14. Uses hand tools to work soil and to remove weeds, undergrowth, and debris from school grounds and landscaped areas.
- 15. Cleans out water drainage in yards and cleans gutters on buildings.
- 16. Builds wooden frames around trees, lawns and shrubs.
- 17. Operates and performs minor service and repair to a variety of related hand and power tools including mowers, sweepers, edgers, sprayers.
- 18. Maintains groundskeeping equipment and supplies to ensure availability in safe operating condition.
- 19. Monitors and responds to District radio communication network.
- 20. Performs other duties similar to the above in scope and function as required.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS:

Knowledge of:

- basic methods, tools, and equipment used in grounds maintenance;
- proper groundskeeping and gardening methods and practices including the fundamentals of and general plant care;
- procedures of groundskeeping and gardening materials, use, care, and safety;
- fundamental grounds requirements for all District outdoor athletic events;
- water systems management and techniques;

- standards for safe use of fertilizers, herbicides, and fungicides;
- groundskeeping and gardening methods and practices;
- safe use and application of pesticides and herbicides for pest/weed control purposes;
- safe use and operation of a variety of tools and equipment used in gardening, repair and grounds maintenance work.

Ability to:

- Read and write at a level sufficient to perform required duties;
- Understand and carry out oral and written instructions independently;
- Perform general groundskeeping and gardening work;
- Operate a variety of tools, machines, and equipment including various types of mowers, trucks, edger, tractor, hedger and chain saw in a safe and effective manner;
- Safely use and operate a variety of hand tools, power tools, and equipment;
- Drive pickup truck;
- Read and interpret landscaping plans;
- Perform basic mathematical calculations;
- Estimate the scope of work assignments and secure necessary tools and materials to complete each assignment;
- Calculate fertilizer and chemical applications safely and effectively;
- Communicate effectively in both oral and written form;
- Meet the physical requirements for performance of assigned duties;
- Maintain effective work relationships with those contacted in the performance of required duties;
- Receive and apply training standards in the above areas provided by the District.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE AND REQUIREMENTS:

- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Prior job related experience.
- Valid driver's license and evidence of insurability.
- TB Test clearance.
- Criminal Justice Fingerprint clearance.

PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS:

- 1. Sufficient vision to read printed material.
- 2. Sufficient hearing to conduct in-person and telephone conversations.
- 3. Understandable voice with sufficient volume and clarity to be heard in normal conversations.
- 4. Sufficient mobility to move about the District and drive a vehicle.
- 5. Sufficient strength to lift 50 lbs. or carry object weighing over 25 lbs.
- 6. Sufficient abilities to push/pull, stoop, and reach/handle.
- 7. Physical, mental and emotional stamina to endure long hours under sometimes stressful conditions.
