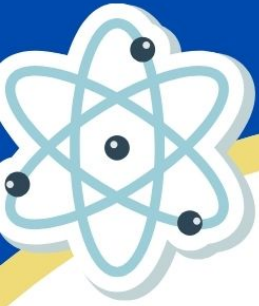

The Center Joint Unified School District Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELOP) offers students the opportunity to receive additional academic support and enrichment at no cost to families. Priority enrollment is for unduplicated students (identified as experiencing homelessness, foster, free and reduced lunch, and English language learners).

\*The program is available to TK through 6th grade students. Programming start and end times vary depending on the school site and staffing.
